A Scheme for Rewarding Meritorious Teachers in the Institutions of Higher Education in Goa is approved by the Government of Goa and taken up for notification to the public.

Scheme for Rewarding Meritorious Teachers in the institutions of Higher Education in Goa

*Background.*— There are about one thousand five hundred teachers in the various

General Degree Colleges of Goa including those in Goa University who are providing their valuable services to enrich Higher Education sector in Goa. There is a scheme under which 8 teachers including Principals Higher Schools Secondary Headmasters of Schools are felicitated every year on the "Teachers Day". The scheme is operated by Directorate of Education. However all these years, the teachers working in professional degree Colleges and in Goa University, were not considered under the scheme as the same was not made applicable to them. This scheme is designed in order to provide an opportunity to such of the eligible College/University teachers for being State Awardees.

*Objectives.*— (1) The Scheme is basically designed with the intention of recognizing selfless and meritorious services rendered by teachers of General Degree Colleges and that of Goa University.

- (2) The Scheme will encourage awardees to serve Higher Education Sector with a renewed vigour and enthusiasm.
- (3) The Scheme will set an example of 'Role Model' teachers before the younger generation of teachers in the Higher Education Sector.

*Eligibility.*— The following shall be eligibility criterion for being State Awardees:

- (1) Only those teachers and Principals who are in service and within the age group of 45 to 55 years on the date of application shall be eligible to apply for State Award. Such of the teachers and Principals should have possessed essential qualifications as required under UGC norms at the time of their appointment.
- (2) The applicant should be full time regular faculty in Goa University/affiliated Colleges who are confirmed in service.
- (3) The applicant should be an outstanding teacher having significant academic contribution. He/she should have been instrumental in uplifting his/her own institution.
- (4) Irrespective of the number of years of service, Permanent Full Time Regular

Teachers should have a very good API score. Teachers should have (i) A minimum API score of 100 points in Category I; (ii) A minimum API score 30 points in Category II and (iii) A minimum API of 400 points in Category III, as prescribed in UGC Notification of 2010. Everything being equal, preference should given to those having maximum points subject to Heads of Institution making a fair assessment of the Teachers.

No. of Awards.— Every year two most meritorious College/University teachers shall be bestowed with the State Award. The award shall consist of Rs. 25,000/- in cash and a citation. The selected teachers shall be entitled for extension of 1 year in service. The awardees shall be felicitated on the teacher's day every year.

Application Procedure.— (1) The Applications for State Award shall be submitted in the prescribed format as placed at Annexure A.

- (2) The Applicant should fill in part 'A' of the format and submit the same to the Head of the respective institution who in turn shall fill in part 'B' of the format and submit the same to the Director of Higher Education who in turn shall place the same before the Selection Committee.
- (3) Proposals should compulsorily be submitted through the Head of the Institution to Directorate of Higher Education. Proposals submitted directly shall not be entertained. Maximum of two proposals could be submitted by an institution. Unsuccessful candidates shall be considered only after a gap of one year in the first instance and cooling period of 3 years subsequently.
- (4) Incomplete proposals shall be summarily rejected.

Guidelines for Institutional Heads for recommendation of Teachers.— (a) The teachers to be recommended for the award shall meet eligibility criteria stipulated for the award.

(b) The teachers academic efficiency and his image as a teacher among students and

community around shall be given due weightage.

- (c) The community service if any rendered by the teacher shall be given due weightage.
- (*d*) Any outstanding achievement by the teacher in the field of Higher Education shall be duly considered.
- (e) The Research Contribution of the teacher in last ten years preceding application in terms of completed minor/major Research projects, guidance for Ph.D./M.Phil, publications in peer reviewed/impact factor journals may also be considered.
- (f) There should be no vigilance case pending against him.

Self-Assessment by the Teacher.— Every applicant should justify as to why he should be considered for State Award. The justification would include his strengths, weaknesses, his achievements and his extraordinary work in the field of Higher Education. The applicant may also define his vision for Higher Education in Goa.

Schedule of selection process.— Duly filled in application forms shall be submitted to Directorate of Higher Education every year latest by 15th July every year.

Selection Committee.— The Government shall constitute a Selection Committee every year headed by an academician of repute. There will be two other members nominated by the Government. The Director, Higher Education shall be Member/Member Secretary.

#### 1/9/2013-PER

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the existing Recruitment Rules for the post of Police Constable notified vide Government Notification No. 1/11/2005-PER dated 24-7-2012, in the Official Gazette, Series I No. 17 dated 26-7-2012, the Governor of Goa hereby makes the following rules to regulate the recruitment to the Group 'C', Non-Gazetted, Non-Ministerial post, in the Office of the Director General of Police, Government of Goa, namely:—

- 1. Short title, application and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Goa, Office of the Director General of Police, Group 'C', Non-Ministerial, Non-Gazetted post, Recruitment Rules, 2017.
- (2) They shall apply to the post specified in column (1) of the Schedule to these rules (hereinafter called as the "said Schedule").
- (3) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number, classification and scale of pay.— The number of posts, classification of the said posts and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule:

Provided that the Government may vary the number of posts as specified in column (2) of the said Schedule from time to time subject to exigencies of work.

- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- 4. *Disqualification.* No person who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living or who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the service:

Provided that the Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. *Power to relax.* Where, the Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving.— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in that regard.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 306, read with section 62 of the Goa Municipalities Act, 1968 (Act No. 7 of 1969) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules so as to further amend the Goa Municipalities (Chairperson's and Other Councillor's Emoluments) Rules, 1970, namely:—

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Goa Municipalities (Chairperson's and Other Councillor's Emoluments (Amendment) Rules, 2017.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Amendment of rule 3.— In sub-rule (1) of rule 3 of the Goa Municipalities (Chairperson's and Other Councillor's Emoluments) Rules, 1970,—
  - (*i*) in clause (*a*), for the figures "9,500/-", "8,500/-" and "8,000/-, the figures "12,825/-", "11,475/-" and "10,800/-" shall be respectively substituted;
  - (*i*) in clause (*b*), for the figures "8,000/-", "7,500/-" and "7,000/-" the figures "10,800/-", "10,125/-" and "9,450/-" shall be respectively substituted; and
  - (*iii*) for clause (*c*), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—
    - "(c) The Government shall reimburse fifty percent of expenditure on honorarium in the case of 'B' Class Municipal Council as per the existing "8,500/-" for Chairperson and "7,500/-" for Councillors and eighty percent of expenditure on honorarium in the case of 'C' Class Municipal Council as per the existing "8,000/-" for Chairperson and "7,000/-" for Councillors."

## DRAFT RULES

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 22A, read with section 391 of the City of Panaji Corporation Act, 2002 (Goa Act 1 of 2003) and all other powers enabling it in this behalf, the Government of Goa hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the City of Panaji Corporation (Mayor's, Deputy Mayor's and other Councillor's Emoluments) Rules, 2017.
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. *Definitions.* (1) In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires,—
  - (a) "Act" means the City of Panaji Corporation Act, 2002 (Goa Act 1 of 2003);

- (b) "section" means a section of the Act.
- (2) Words and expressions used but not defined in these rules shall have the same meaning as are assigned to them in the Act.
- 3. Honorarium payable to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Councillors.— (1) The Mayor shall be entitled to draw a maximum honorarium of Rs. 12,825/- per month.
- (2) The Deputy Mayor and the Councillor shall be entitled to draw a maximum honorarium of Rs. 10,800/- per month.
- (3) The Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Councillors shall not be entitled for any honorarium in case of their absence in the Corporation for a continuous period exceeding 30 days except on medical ground certified by a registered medical practitioner.
- 4. Allowances payable to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Councillors.— The Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Councillors shall be entitled to actual transport charges as travelling allowance for attending meeting of the Standing Committee and Special Consultative Committee.
- 5. Debiting of expenditure on honorarium and allowances.— The expenditure on account of the honorarium or allowances in a financial year, shall be debited respectively to the Budget Head "Honorarium or allowances to the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and the Councillors" and met by the Corporation from its own fund for that year under the said Budget Head.

The Amendment of the Scheme shall come into force from 1st April, 2011 and all mothers who deliver live girl child (maximum 2 deliveries) and child born on or after 1st April, 2011 shall be entitled for benefits under the Scheme.
