### Highlights





## Agriculture

### **Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi**

8367 farmers in Goa have received ₹ 6,000 per year under this scheme.

### **Soil Health Card**

Goa Government has issued a total of 56,937 Soil Health Cards to farmers in the State.

### **Pradhan Mantri Kisan Maandhan**

Under this scheme, farmers are provided with ₹ 3,000 pension per month after the age of 60 years.

147 farmers are registered under this scheme in Goa.

### **Blue Revolution (Neel Kranti Mission)**

The scheme was introduced to develop, manage and promote fisheries. The central government has allocated ₹ 19.26 crores to Goa till 2021.

### **Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana Watershed Development Component (PMKSY-WDC)**

The objective of this scheme is to expand cultivable area under assured irrigation, improve on-farm water use efficiency to reduce wastage of water and introduce usage of other water saving technologies.

Under this scheme 597 Projects have been implemented.





## Healthcare



### **Ayushman Bharat**

A total of 21,867 Ayushman cards have been issued in Goa & more than ₹ 33 crore have been disbursed.

### **Ayushman Bharat (Health and Wellness Centres)**

This scheme has aided launch of 161 Health and Wellness Centres in Goa.

### **Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP)**

There are 10 operational PMBJP Kendras in Goa.



### **Ayush Hospitals**

The Government of India has approved, two 50-bedded (AYUSH) hospitals in Goa – one in each district.

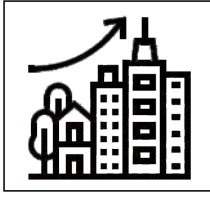


### **Super Speciality Hospital**

Central Government has funded the construction of the state of the art infrastructure of Super Speciality Unit at Goa Medical College Hospital in Bambolim. this 550 bedded hospital is constructed at a cost of ₹ 375 cr

### **National Health Mission**

The National Health Mission (NHM) encompasses its two Sub-Missions, the National Rural Health Mission (NRHM) and the National Urban Health Mission (NUHM). The major focus areas of the scheme are development of health facilities in rural and urban areas. Central Government has given a grant of ₹ 74.69 crores under both the sub missions to the State of Goa.



## Urban Development

### Smart Cities

₹ 950 Cr have been sanctioned by the central government for Panaji smart city.

The flow of investments from the government has helped improve the basic amenities of the city and, in turn, improved the living standards of the people.



### Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

The scheme is aimed at providing basic services such as water supply, sewerage, urban transport to households and building amenities in cities that will improve the quality of life. Of the 15 projects sanctioned by the central government for Goa, 9 have been completed.

### Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban)

The central government has released ₹ 67.72 crores to build 3,097 houses under this scheme.



### Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana (National Urban Livelihoods Mission)

7 shelters have been constructed as temporary residences.

### PM SVANIDHI

1,405 loans have been disbursed under this scheme.



## Roads & Infrastructure

### National Highways

Six highway projects in Goa involving a cost of ₹ 3,860 Cr.  
Widening of Belagavi-Panjim NH-4A Road Upgradation Project worth ₹ 3631.9 Cr.

### Zuari Bridge

The bridge second longest and widest cable stay bridge in India is nearing completion.

The eight-lane Zuari bridge is an ambitious ₹ 2,300 crore project. Two tourist view towers worth ₹ 130 crore have been planned for construction on the bridge. It will comprise of an observatory & viewing gallery, revolving restaurant and art gallery. This new bridge will solve the long commute problems across the two banks of the Zuari river.

### Manohar Parrikar Canacona Bypass

The 4 lane highway with 3 bridges over Galgibagh, Talpona & Maxem has reduced the existing distance of 21.4 km to 7.7 km

### Atal Setu

It is Goa's longest bridge and India's third longest cable-stayed bridge. A total budget of ₹ 550 crores was utilised for construction of the Atal Setu.



### Mopa airport

The Mopa Airport, a Greenfield airport in Pernem taluka is expected to ultimately handle 28 million passengers per annum. This project is expected to enhance domestic & international tourism, create revenue and serve as a massive job drive for Goan youth.





## Industries and Job creation

### Konkan Maritime Cluster

This is the 1st Maritime Cluster of India set up in Goa under MSME with an aim to generate employment and also complement our Shipbuilding industry.



### Tuem EMC

The Union ministry of electronics and information technology has funded the Tuem electronics manufacturing cluster. This organisation aims at creating an eco system for electronic industries and promoting local employment.



## Rural Development

### Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Gramin)

Under the scheme, 237 houses were built in the State of Goa.

### National River Conservation Plan

The central government has sanctioned ₹ 14.09 Crores to Goa to revive the aquatic system of the Mandovi river.

### Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojana

This scheme is aimed at increasing employment opportunities in rural areas, reducing migration, freeing people from bonded labour, child labour, manual scavenging and achieving 100% registration of deaths & births. 71 Gram Panchayat have been identified under SADY I and II, with a completion rate of 24.62%.

### Swachh Bharat Gramin

28,637 Individual Household Latrines were constructed, with Goa becoming the first Open Defecation Free State in India.



### Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Gram Jyoti Yojana

13 number of 11KV centers were built in the rural areas of Goa.

### Saubhagya Yojana

Goa has achieved 100% electrification under this scheme.

### **Jal Jeevan Mission**

Goa has connected 100% of the households with tap water by providing 63,919 connections to Goan people with a budget allocation of ₹ 65.51 crores by the Central Government.



### **Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana**

This scheme is tasked with the dual objectives of adding diversity to the incomes of rural poor families and catering to the career aspirations of rural youth. 740 placements were made under this scheme.

## **Social Welfare**



### **Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana [PMJDY]**

In Goa, 171,050 people have benefited from this scheme.

### **Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojna (PMKVY)**

A total of 8,660 candidates from Goa have been certified under the scheme.

### **Atal Pension Yojana (APY)**

27,204 Goans receive benefits under this scheme.

### **Pradhan Mantri Ujala Yojana**

10,05,890 LED bulbs have been distributed in Goa.

### **Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram**

PMJVK is implemented in all districts of the country with an aim of social inclusion and provision of basic amenities.

### **Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana (PMMY)**

A total amount of ₹ 1943.62 crores has been disbursed to micro, small and medium enterprises.

### **Pradhan Mantri Rojgar Protsahan Yojana (PMRPY)**

583 establishments and 26,025 employees benefited through a subsidy of ₹ 19.82 crores in Goa.

### **Pradhan Mantri Surakshit Matritva Abhiyan (PMSMA)**

34,505 pregnant women are provided with healthcare facilities under PMSMA.

## Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme

2,904 Goan Youth have benefited and ₹ 9.6 crores have been sanctioned under the scheme.



## Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana

3922 SHGs are provided with funds worth ₹ 925.86 lakhs, under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana



## Environment



### FAME

This scheme operates under the objective of promoting electric mobility and financial incentives for enhancing electric vehicle production and creation of electric transportation infrastructure. Kadamba Transport Corporation Limited has incorporated 100 electric buses in its fleet introducing eco sustainable public transport in the state under this scheme. Goa Government is investing in a perpetual effort to adapt 100% electrification of the KTCL fleet.

## Safety and Security

### National Disaster Management Authority

Goa Government has trained 400 Aapda Sakhi and Mitra for assisting the Community during any disaster. Directorate of Fire and Emergency Services, has been nominated as the Nodal Authority for implementation of the Scheme. Cyclone shelters have been built in various parts of Goa.



### Goa Police

The police personnel of Goa have achieved the highest crime solving rate, one of the best in India. The state's first Cyber Forensics Laboratory is operational at the Goa police's Cyber Crime Cell at Ribandar. The lab is expected to help improve detection of cyber crimes in the state.

Goa Police has a dedicated tourist police force with personnel adorning key tourist locations following patrolling and beach vigil protocols.



### Pink Force

Goa has become the first state to introduce Pink Force in order to prevent crimes against women and children. This team consists of 250 personnel and runs its operations at continuity all over the state.





## Central Government's aid during COVID



### Vaccination Drive

Total 13,15,94,160 vaccine doses provided by Central Government have been administered in the state of Goa with Goa completing 100% vaccination.

### PM Garib Kalyan Anna (अन्न) Yojana

PMGKAY is a food security welfare scheme announced during the COVID-19 pandemic in India under which 5kg food grains & 1kg pulses were provided to vulnerable households.

5.32 lakh Goans availed this scheme in the state of Goa.



### PM-CARES

Oxygen plants were set up in Goa under the PM-CARES Fund at Goa Medical College and both district hospitals which addressed the oxygen requirement of hospitals in the state during the surge of COVID-19 in the State.



## **Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan**

Under the scheme Goa has been allocated ₹48.92 crores.



## **Education**

### **Samagra Shiksha**

It is an overarching program for the school education sector extending from pre-school to class XII and aims to ensure inclusive and equitable quality education at all levels of school education. ₹ 44.15 crores are sanctioned under this programme to Goa.

### **Pradhan Mantri Poshan Shakti Nirman (PM POSHAN)**

Funds released by the centre under this scheme are ₹ 4.56 crores.

### **Centre Scholarship Schemes(Pre/Post Matric)**

10,572 students have been awarded this scholarship.

### **India International University of Legal Education & Research**

IIULER a world-class and first-of-its-kind international legal education institute in the country is now housed in Goa.

### **National Forensic Sciences University**

National Forensic Sciences University Transit Campus was inaugurated in Goa. It offers 5 year BSc MSc Forensic Science, 2 year MSc Forensic Science, MSc Digital Forensic Science and MSc Cyber Security courses.



### **IIT Goa**

An academic inclusion in Goa's journey to become an education hub is temporarily housed at Farmagudi and will be provided with an ambitious campus soon.



### **NIT, Goa**

National Institute of Technology has housed its new campus at Cuncolim in South Goa. Faculties ranging from Computer Science to Civil Engineering are available at the institute. NIT, Goa has reserved 40% seats for Goan students.

### **School Infrastructures**

608 schools have been upgraded in the state in order to provide modern education facilities and infrastructure to the students.





## Women Welfare

### **Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojna (PMMVY)**

19,783 Goan women have benefited from this scheme

### **Ujjwala Yojana**

Central Government has provided 1081 LPG connections in Goa.



### **Mission Indradhanush Immunisation Drive**

Central Government has immunized 826 children and 54 mothers in the State.

### **Supplementary Nutrition Programme under Anganwadi Services Scheme**

79, 951 Goans have availed monthly ration through Supplementary Nutrition Programme under this Scheme.



### **Poshan Abhiyan**

Poshan Abhiyan was introduced with an aim to reduce malnutrition in India. The scheme focuses on curbing malnutrition among children, adolescent girls also pregnant and lactating women. Funds released by the Central Government to Goa under this scheme amount to ₹ 16.07 cr.



### **Female Literacy**

Central Government has allocated ₹ 666.50 lakhs under this scheme where ₹ 25000 are given to school going girls to boost the female literacy ratio. 2,666 girls have benefited from this scheme.



## Tourism



### Swadesh Darshan

A total budget of ₹ 300 crore has been allotted to Goa by Government of India under Swadesh Darshan scheme.

Fort Aguada has been renovated as a part of developing tourism avenues in the State through this initiative. Swadesh Darshan scheme is envisioned to promote tourism sector as a major engine for job creation and a driving force for economic growth. This 100% centrally funded scheme is benefiting Goa with its contribution to development of tourist facilitation services to enhance visitor experience.



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
